

INTERNSHIP OFFER – development of the UBO international programme for the Brest 2020 Maritime Festivals

As part of the organisation of the Brest 2020 Maritime Festivals, the UBO's International Relations Department is offering a 6-month internship.

MISSIONS

The intern will be responsible for supporting the design, logistical organization and promotion of the international programme of the Brest 2020 Maritime Festivals at UBO, including hosting delegations of UBO's strategic international partners.

Every four years, the Brest Maritime Festivals bring together an audience of several hundred thousand people around the international maritime heritage. UBO honours and welcomes its strategic partners (research, academic and institutional collaborations) as part of this major international event, which will take place from July 10 to 16, 2020.

The missions of the internship will include:

- the technical, logistical and budgetary organisation of the reception of delegations;
- the implementation of a programme of meetings and exchanges of international delegations in connection with the types of collaborations developed (academic, research, etc.);
- dissemination and internal communication on the international aspect of Maritime Festivals within the UBO community;
- assistance in the development of content (text and images) for digital communication (newsletters, social networks, etc.);

The internship will be carried out at the UBO under the supervision of: Léa SHARKEY, Director of International Relations at UBO.

The trainee will work in conjunction with the dedicated central services (Communication Department, etc.)
